

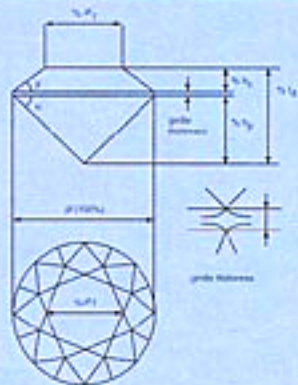
COLOUR

CUT

On an HRD certificate, the description of the cut is split into a separate description of the proportions (angles of inclination and proportional relations between the various parts of the stone) and finish, which is mainly concerned with symmetry deviations and the positioning of the facets.
